Level 1 - information or advice via Surrey Family Information Service (FIS) tel: 0300 200 1004 or go to www.surreycc.gov.uk/fis

**Level 2** - early help via the Early Help Co-ordination Hub

Level 3 - assessment under s.17 Children Act

**Level 4** - child protection investigation s.47 Children Act, which may then lead to child in need or child protection interventions.

Referrers to the MASH and Early Help Co-ordination Hubs will be provided with feedback as to the services provided in response to the child's assessed level of need.
