



Music Curriculum Map

Nursery

Rhymes and songs EYFS: Move while singing/vocalizing, listen to sounds and music while playing with sound makers/instruments. Christmas songs

Rhymes and songs EYFS: Taps simple repeated rhythms, learn songs and create sounds by rubbing, shaking, tapping, striking or blowing.

Rhymes and songs EYFS: Experiment with sound makers and instruments experiment with ways of playing loud/quiet, fast/slow building a collection of songs and dances.

Reception

Join in and sing a range of songs Performing songs and rhymes EYFS: Sing familiar songs, e.g. pop songs, songs from TV programmes, rhymes, songs from home. Christmas Nativity

Beginning to explore music making and 'listen and apprise' EYFS: Make music in a range of ways, play with sounds creatively, play along to the beat of the song they are singing or music.

Moving expressively to a range of songs EYFS: Explore and learn how sounds and movements can be changed. Develop an understanding of how to create and use sounds intentionally.

Year 1

Musical dimension: 'beat'
Christmas concert

Musical dimension: 'timbre' Using their voices expressively and creatively and speaking chants

Musical skills: improvisation and performance Using their voices expressively and creatively by singing rhymes. Sing Up Day

Year 2

Playing in an orchestra Musical dimensions: 'pulse, rhythm and pitch' Christmas concert

Musical skills: composition Listen with concentration and understanding to a range of high-quality live and recorded music Experiment with, create, select and combine sounds using the inter-related dimensions of music.

Musical skills: improvisation and performance Play tuned and untuned instruments musically - learning to play recorders Sing Up Day

Year 3

Writing down music and playing in the band Play and perform in solo and ensemble contexts. Learning to play the ukulele - specialist provision from Surrey Arts Christmas concert

Musical skill composition: 'performance' Use voices and play musical instruments with increasing accuracy, fluency, control and expression. African drumming - specialist music teacher

Musical skills: improvisation and performance Improve and compose music for a range of purposes using the inter-related dimensions of music Sing Up Day

Year 4

Musical skill composition: 'performance' Use and understand staff and other musical notations African drumming - specialist music teacher Christmas concert

Musical skills: improvisation and performance Appreciate and understand a wide range of high-quality live and recorded music. Garage Band - composing and performing electronic music - specialist teaching from Surrey Arts

Musical dimension: 'Structure and expression' Listen with attention to detail and recall sounds with increasing aural memory Sing Up Day

Year 5

Musical skills: improvisation and performance Develop an understanding of the history of music from a certain period. African drumming - specialist music teacher Christmas concert

Musical dimension: 'composition' Appreciate and understand a wide range of high-quality live and recorded music drawn from different traditions and from great composers and musicians. Learning to play the guitar - specialist teaching from Surrey Arts

Musical dimension: 'melody and harmony' Appreciate and understand a range of live and recorded music. Sing Up Day

Year 6

Christmas concert

Musical skills: improvisation and performance Compare the musical of composers from different time periods. African drumming - specialist music teaching

Musical dimension: 'composition' Compare a range of historical music from different time periods Garage Band- performing and composing electronic music - specialist teaching from Surrey Arts Sing Up Day
