English (Reading & Writing)

In our writing this half term, we will be writing a Non-Chronological based on the wonderful world of food. This will be linked heavily to our topic. We will then be focusing on the text 'The Boy at the Back of the Class' where we will be developing our skills in writing a newspaper report and a narrative in the form of an alternative ending to the story.

Maths

In Maths, we will be continuing with the Maths, No Problem Singapore-style of mastery maths teaching. This term pupils will learn how to calculate percentages of an amount and how we use percentages to increase and decrease an amount. Pupils will also start their geometry unit, and this will be focused around the properties of 2D and 3D shapes. Taking this further, pupils will consider how this information is key to solving problems in context.

Key Skills: Maths No Problem Fractions, Decimals and Percentages: Percentage, Geometry: Properties of Shapes

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Science - Living Things & Habitats

Pupils will study the differences in life cycles of a mammal, an amphibian, an insect and a bird. They will develop skills in being able to describe the process of reproduction in some plants and animals.

Topic - Geography - Sow, Grow and Farm

Pupils will learn about the use of land in the UK, allotments and farming and be able to offer reasons for the geographical impact on people or places. Map skills and the ability to use grid references will also be developed.
