Mrs Roshni Jones will become a specialist art teacher next year and we are able to continue with outdoor learning and introduce forest school into our curriculum.

Our strong support staff team will continue to provide excellent additional support in classes, for groups of children as well as providing in class SEND support.

We are really looking forward to the academic year ahead; we have an incredibly strong, committed and positive staff team in all aspects of the school. We have invested heavily in resources across the school to support teaching and learning, and we will continue to invest in the school environment to ensure our school is the best it can be for our children.
