

Accommodation

Rooms sleep up to 6 children. Children will be asked preferences of buddies and we will endeavour to ensure at least 1 person in each group.

Adult rooms are located within the blocks of accommodation.





Food

- Lighter tastier lunches a pit-stop to prepare for a busy afternoon. Refuel with fresh sandwiches, soups, pasta or salads.

Medication

- Any school medication will be taken on the trip with the child's medication plan.
- All medication will be with an adult in the child's group at all times so that it is available as and when needed or at set times according to instructions.
- Any medication must be handed into the office by Fri 23rd Feb at the latest.
- PGL staff are first aid trained and they have a first aid facility if further treatment is needed.

Children will receive praise and recognition for displaying our principles and certainties in line with the strategies in school.

All children whose behaviour does not meet expectations may receive a consequence proportionate to the circumstance.

During the residential, as in school, if a child receives a level 2 or 3 reflection then you will be informed via a phone call. If the school deems it necessary, we will request a child be collected from the site for the duration of the trip.

If a child is not following the school behaviour policy in school, then they will not be able to attend the residential.

Rewards

- Room competition
- House points

Consequences

- Missing time from an activity
- Missing the evening activities
- Phone call home
- Parents called to collect

Communication

- Teachers will be in daily contact with the school.
- Tweets will be posted on the Year 3 and Year 4 Twitter pages.
- All members of staff will have their phones for emergency purposes and if they need to make contact, they will call using a withheld number.
- If a child were really unsettled and we thought there was a need to make contact, we would call. However, this is very rare as they are too busy having fun!
