## PARENT FORUM 12.11.2019

Mrs Wright discussed the school improvement priorities which are available to look at on our website.

Reading – New and improved reading records have been introduced across the school.

Reading around the world will be replaced by a reading achievement certificate, this will be given out during our celebration assembly each week. We will also be reviewing alternative incentives to promote reading.

Phonics Workshops will be announced in the coming months.

With regards to handwriting past inconsistencies across the campuses were acknowledged. A handwriting workshop has taken place for teachers where strategies such as using dyslexic friendly paper were discussed. This back to basics approach will then be rolled out, with children gaining their pen licenses again very soon.

A question was raised regarding the library. All books are being moved into the classrooms, books will be rotated through each campus to give a greater choice and provide more interesting texts for pupils.

SLT are observing all teaching throughout the school to ensure consistency.

‘Maths No Problem’ has now been introduced into the school. Fast feedback during class is being used to provide immediate support to those who need it and to keep all pupils on track.

Developing leaders across the school to support in planning and preparation. There has been a change to the leadership structure. Mr Jonny Franks is our Inclusion Assistant Head and one of his roles is to ensure the teachers have the right provision within the classroom for all pupils.
